The Future of Robotics

The University of Leeds is undertaking a £4.3m project to develop small robots to identify problems with utility pipes, street lights and roads and fix them with minimal environmental impact and disruption to the public. Known as Fire and Forget, where researchers will develop robots that will inspect, repair, meter and report on live utility pipes.

You will also be able to tour the robots facility equipment and see robots including the 'Djedi robot' that explored the great pyramid of Giza.

The evening will begin at 17:00 with a light buffet and refreshments and finish at 19:00 and take place in Room 153a, on the first floor of the School of Electronic and Electrical Engineering, University of Leeds.
